BLESS Eat Together

But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect. - **1 Peter 3:15**

People who were nothing like Jesus liked Jesus because He ate with them.

After this, Jesus went out and saw a tax collector by the name of Levi sitting at his tax booth. "Follow Me," Jesus said to him... - **Luke 5:27**

...and Levi got up, left everything and followed Him. - **Luke 5:28**

Then Levi held a great banquet for Jesus at his house, and a large crowd of tax collectors and others were eating with them. - **Luke 5:29**

A shared table is a shared life.

4 things eating accomplishes:

1. Eating together provides an opportunity to develop relational bridges.
2. Eating together is an opportunity to drop spiritual hints and clues.
3. Eating together is an opportunity to learn people's stories.
4. Eating together is an opportunity to discern next steps.
