Confession overcomes the power of guilt.

Blessed is the one whose sin the Lord does not count against them and in whose spirit is no deceit. When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night your hand was heavy on me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord." And you forgave the guilt of my sin. **Psalm 32:2-5**

We all need to confess.

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. **Romans 3:23**

Confession happens on two levels.

First, we confess our sins to God.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. **I John 1:9**

God forgives and forgets our sins.

He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west. **Psalm 103:12**

Second, we confess our sins to one another.

Therefore, **confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed**. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working. **James 5:16**

Forgiveness displaces anger.

Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, **forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.**
Ephesians 4:31-32

Forgiving others benefits your spiritual life.

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins. **Matthew 6:14-15**

Forgiveness is not passive.

So watch yourselves. "If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents forgive him. **If he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times comes back to you and says, 'I repent,' forgive him.**"
Luke 17:3-4

Forgiveness is a process.

Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" **Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven."**
Matthew 18:21-22

We should forgive others even when they don't ask for forgiveness.

And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on His right and one on His left. And Jesus said, "**Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.**"
Luke 23:33-34

God is not angry at you. He is waiting for you.

To Him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name. **Acts 10:43**

Forgiveness makes room for the Holy Spirit. And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ **for the forgiveness of your sins**, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 2:38**
